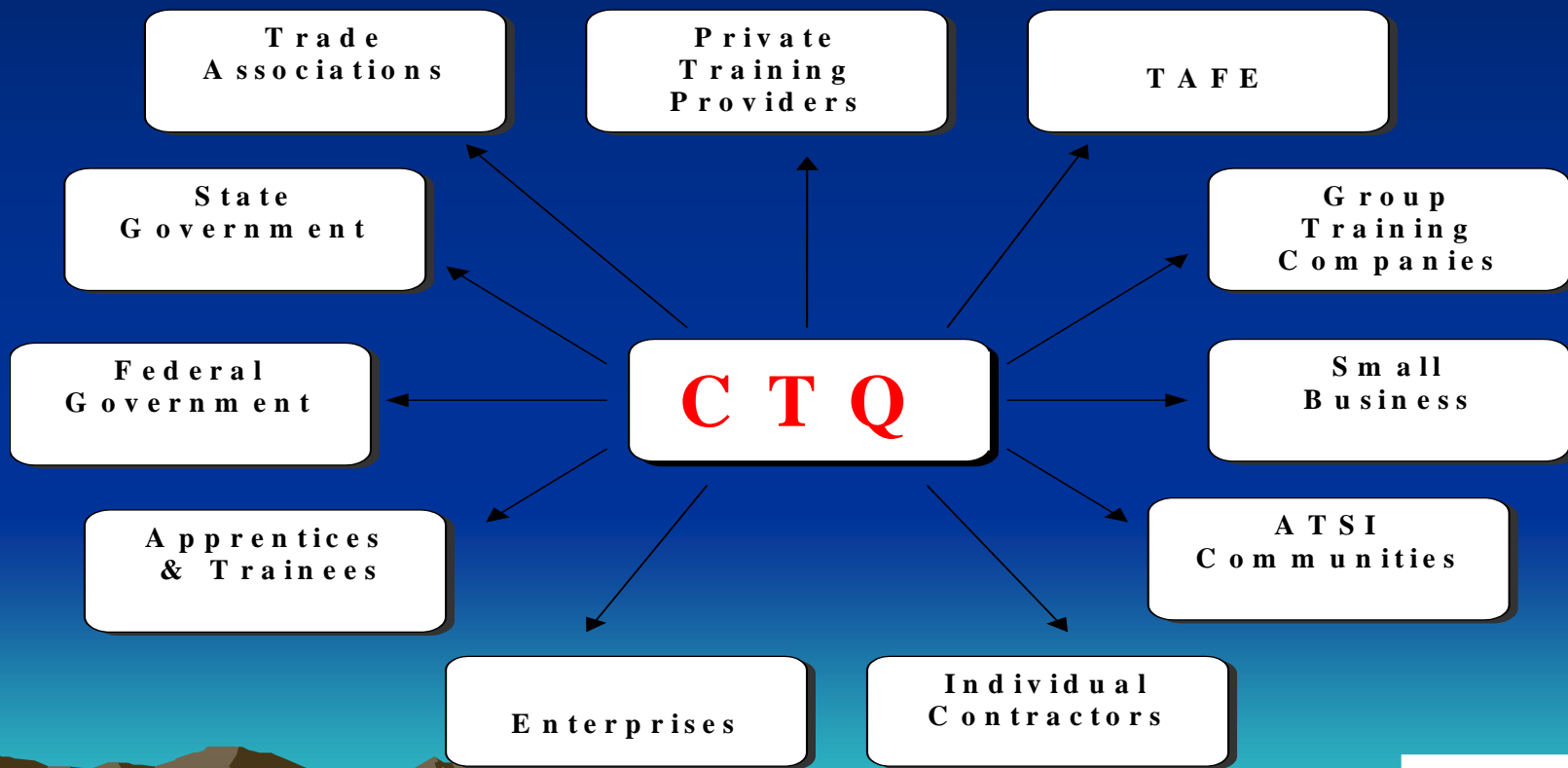


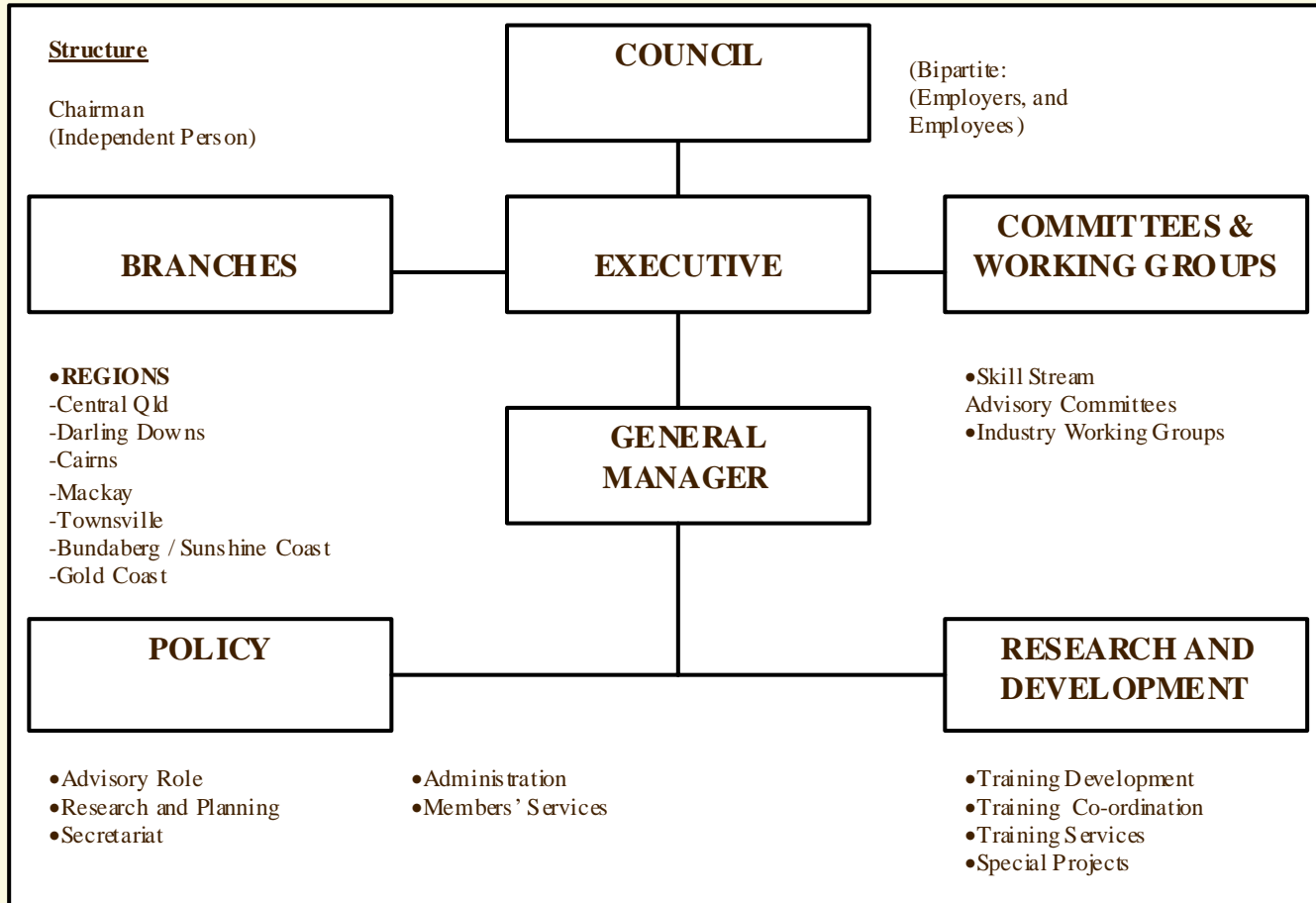
WHO IS CTQ?

Construction Training Queensland is the principal advisor on the training needs for the Building and Construction Industry in Queensland.

CTQ works with the industry and government to make sure that the training needs of employees and employers are addressed.

In other words we ensure that the industry gets its share of the training dollar!





BRIEF HISTORY

- 1998 - National Training Package for Civil Construction (BCC98) endorsed for AQF 1-3 only – CTA (ITAB) responsibility
- AQTF introduced in 1 July 2002
- 2001 - Review of BCC98 and (proposed) development of AQF 4-6 in Civil
- Mid 2002 – Commonwealth Government reviews advisory arrangements (ITABS out/ISC in)
- AQF 4-6 on hold – Until National ISC

BRIEF HISTORY

- Sep 2003 – RIISC declared
- Nov 2003 – BCC98 review completed
- Dec 2003 – NTQC endorses BCC03 (available for delivery)
- May 2004 - CTA closes down
- August 2004 – BCC03 implemented Qld
- July 2004 - RIISC commences project for development of AQF 4-6 in Civil (18 month project)
- March 2004 - Timber Bridge Qualification to NTQC for inclusion into BCC03 Training Package

WHAT VET IS AVAILABLE IN CIVIL COSTRUCTION?

 - No Certificate 1 (dropped from BCC98)
 - No AQF 4-6 (development in progress)
 - Timber Bridge Qual at NTQC (for inclusion)
- Local Government Training Package LGA04
 - Cert I to Advanced Dip (Operational Works)

THE NATIONAL TRAINING FRAMEWORK IN QUEENSLAND

- Declared Traineeships:
 - All Certificate II qualifications
 - All Certificate III qualifications except:
 - Plant Operations (Apprenticeship)
 - Certificate III in Civil Construction
- Qualifications with no declaration
 - Certificate III in Civil Construction (IR Issues)



POST TRADE (AQF 4-6) QUALIFICATIONS

- Project in progress (July 2004)
- Make – up
 - Certificate IV
 - Diploma
 - Advanced Diploma
- Due for completion December 2005
- Implementation in Queensland (Mid 2006)
- Included into BCC03 Training Package
